## Allowance Increase for **Hearing Aid Benefit**

Effective February 1, 2013, the Board of Trustees has agreed to increase the allowance for the hearing aid benefit from \$700 to \$1,500 per ear. This benefit has a limitation of once every 5 years and the allowance is subject to the deductible.
